The Distinguished Service Award, a medallion, is the most prestigious award given by the Northeast Region of CSI. Its purpose is for the Region to give special recognition to those individuals whose long-term commitment, exemplary performance, and significant contributions have helped the Region and their chapter to develop, grow and improve. The Distinguished Service Award is not intended to duplicate the honor and recognition conferred by the national award of Institute Fellowship, but rather to recognize those individuals whose activity has been primarily at the local and regional level in support of the Northeast Region and its chapters. Those nominated for this award must have been a member in good standing for a minimum of 10 years.

W. Calvin Bowne exemplifies the concept of providing service to the Chapter and the Region over an extended period of time. Cal has been an ACTIVE member for over 50 years.

Cal received the Institute President's Special Award when serving as the Institute Director at the time of the formation of the Region. Almost 35 years later, when the Institute went through a governance reorganization that separated the roles of Institute Director and Region Officers, he stepped up as the first Region Vice President under the new structure.
